Discussion and Application Questions From The Message: (30 -35 Minutes)

- 1. When you hear the phrase "Jesus, the Lamb of God," what thoughts, images, and feelings come to mind?
- 2. What do you think about using imagery of a lamb in the life of Jesus and the story of scripture?
- 3. Reference John 1:19-34 for this question. What attitude did John have concerning his role and his view of Jesus? How hard do you think it would have been for John, who was prominent in his own right, to have this attitude?
- 4. Read Isaiah 53. What verse, or verses, impacts you most in this prophecy concerning Jesus? Why did you choose that particular verse or verses?
- 5. Jesus, the Lamb of God, had power over disease and sickness, demons and impure spirits, and even death. Which is most impressive in your mind? Do you have a favorite story in the Bible where Jesus demonstrates this power?
- 6. Jesus was despised, rejected, and crucified for you. Do you ever take this incredible sacrifice for granted? If so, why do you think we do that from time to time?
- 7. John 14:6 teaches Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life. What do those words mean to you when you hear them?
- 8. John 14:6 says that no one comes to the Father except through Jesus. This doesn't resonate with the culture of today. How do we get over the push to be "politically correct" and hold to the truth of this passage?
- 9. Hebrews 8:1 teaches that Jesus is our High Priest. What does it mean to you that He is our High Priest?
- 10. Read I John 2:1. How is Jesus our advocate when we sin and how does that encourage, strengthen, or motivate you in your walk with Him?
