1. When situations seem insurmountable, or circumstances appear to be too difficult to handle, what do most people do?
2. What advice would you give when those situations, or circumstances, seem insurmountable?
3. Gideon's story is found in Judges 6-8. As we discuss this story, what do you think about God allowing the Israelites to suffer at the hands of invading armies for 7 years, due to their rebellion? Does that seem harsh to you? Why or why not?
4. Gideon questioned God about being used by Him. Gideon said he was the least member of the smallest clan. What does this teach you about God?
5. At multiple times in Gideon's conversation with the Lord, Gideon asked for a sign to be sure that this was the Lord and His plan for Gideon. What do you think about his asking for a sign?
6. Would there be something today, in our lives, that is comparable to Gideon asking for a sign?
7. What do you think Gideon thought when the number of men he was going to go into battle with was trimmed from the thousands to only 300?
8. What does it say about our God, and Gideon's faith, that 300 could be victorious over an army much larger and stronger?
9. All that Gideon and his men would be armed with were trumpets, jars, and torches. How much confidence do you think Gideon felt in God delivering victory? How confident would you have been?
10. Read Romans 8:31. What do you think about this verse and how do you think it applies to our lives today?
